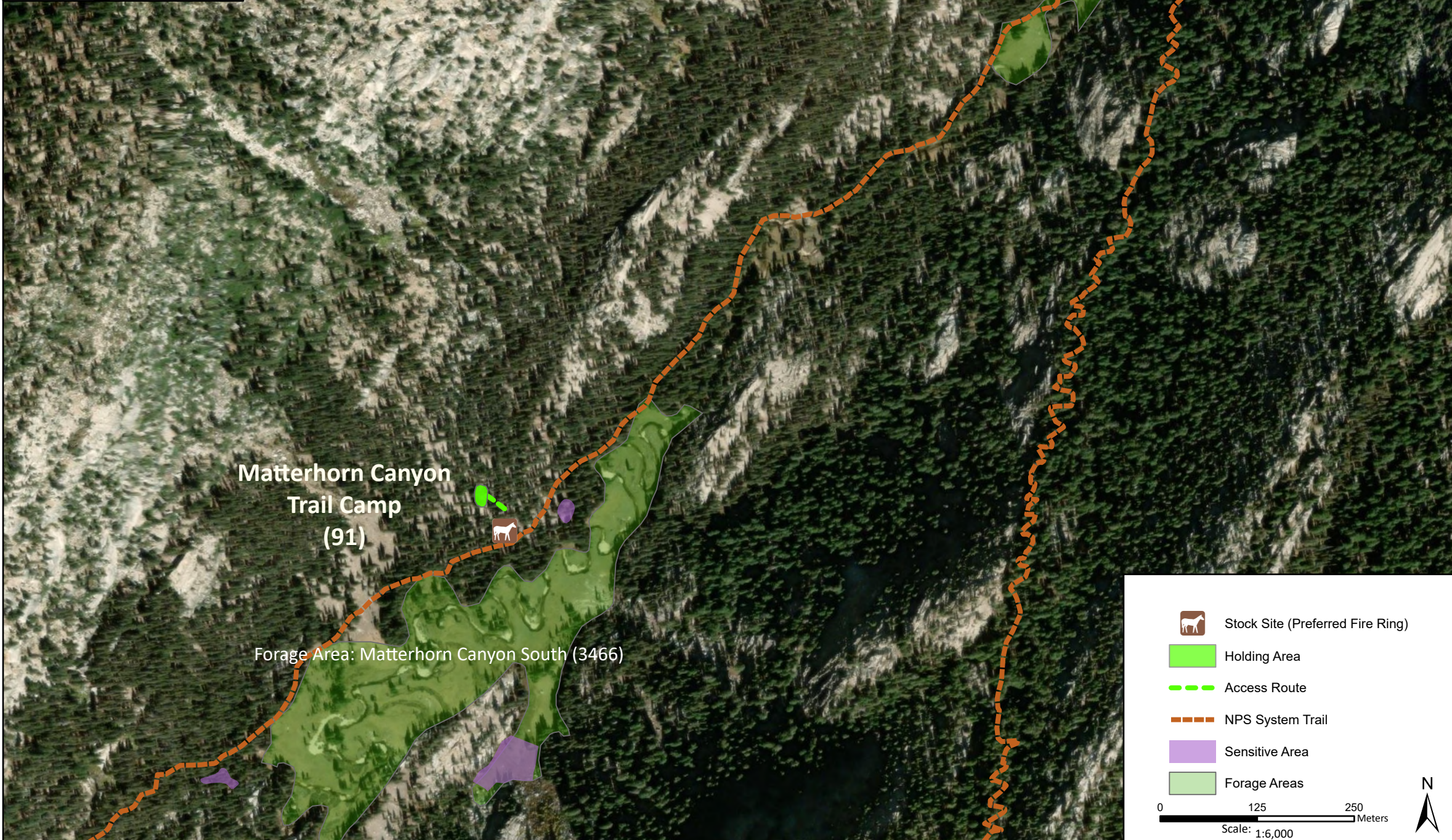
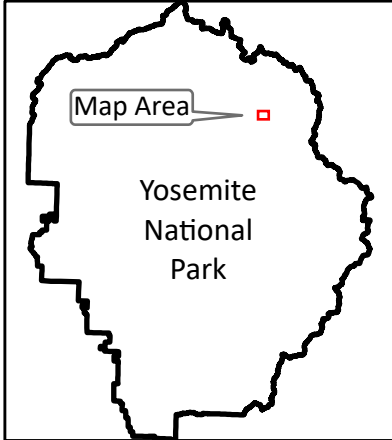

Forage Area: Matterhorn Canyon North (3499) - at Matterhorn Canyon - Junction Camp there is a small meadow on both sides of Matterhorn Creek and surrounding understory forage.

Matterhorn Canyon South (3466) - at Matterhorn Canyon - Trail Camp there is a large meadow on both sides of the creek and surrounding understory forage.

**Matterhorn Canyon - Junction Camp**

Camp ID: 76  
 Fire Ring: 287,996mE x 4,210,104mN  
 Handling Practices: This site is approximately 60 m southwest of where the Pacific Crest Trail crosses Matterhorn Creek. The fire ring is approximately 20 m up the slope west of the trail. The unloading area is at the fire ring. The access route to the holding area starts 30 m northeast of the fire ring on the trail and then heads up the slope 60 m northwest to a flat area overlooking the meadow.

Annual Grazing Capacity: 25 stock use nights

**Matterhorn Canyon - Trail Camp**

Camp ID: 91  
 Fire Ring: 287,259mE x 4,209,344mN  
 Handling Practices: This site is approximately 0.7 mile southwest of where the Pacific Crest Trail crosses Matterhorn Creek. The fire ring is 30 m south of the trail. The unloading area is at the fire ring. The holding area is 30 m northwest of the trail in a large sandy flat.

Annual Grazing Capacity: 130 stock use nights
